**RE:** 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Athletic Scholarship Notice

The St. Paul's Athletic Committee feels that an important part of the Parish Athletic program should be the recognition of those students who embody the ideals (i.e. spirituality, sportsmanship, athletic achievement, scholarship, service) that we are looking to foster in our sports program. It is the intention that selected students would serve as examples and role models to their peers. To this end, the Committee will sponsor two \$1,000 scholarship bonds that will be awarded this year to one graduating 8<sup>th</sup> grade girl and boy.

Listed below is an outline of the scholarship. Applications and scholarship guidelines are available online at the Parish website ([www.stpaulsprinceton.org](http://www.stpaulsprinceton.org)) on the Athletics homepage.

### Process

All St. Paul's Parish 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who participated on an approved SPAC athletic team/clinic (including Cheerleading) during their 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade years are eligible to apply in accordance with stated requirements.

The Committee will attempt to select one male and/or one female applicant each year. All applications will be evaluated by a subcommittee of SPAC that will employ a blind selection system based on a point system in an effort to come to an objective selection. Each selected candidate must meet certain baseline criteria and have no outstanding issues with SPAC (i.e. unpaid fees, incomplete documentation, returned all equipment/uniforms) in order to be eligible for the award. All awards, if any, will be awarded at the Annual Sports Banquet in May, 2009. The award will be a \$500 savings bond.

All decisions of the SPAC Scholarship Selection Committee are considered final.

### Deadline

All completed applications with all supporting documentation must be received by the Selection Committee c/o John Simone, Scholarship Chairperson, St. Paul Athletic Committee **by no later than April 19, 2010** in order to be considered.
